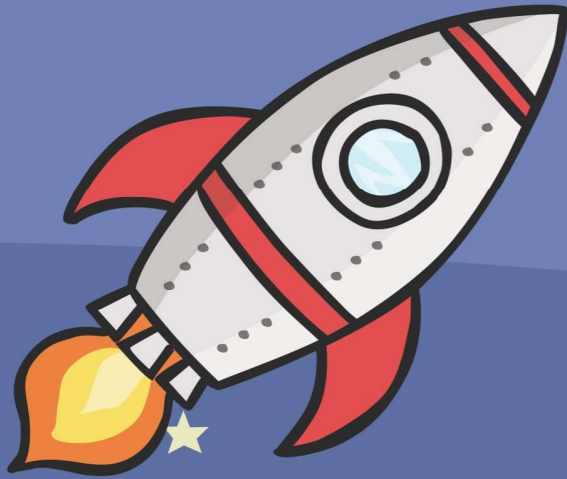


Orange Class Term 5: Up, Up and Away



Maths

We will be revisiting +, -, × and ÷ and using them to solve problems. We will continue to practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and link them to division. We will also revisit 2D/3D shape, symmetry and time.

PE

We will be working on our throwing, catching, running and jumping skills. We will also participate in team games and develop tactics for attacking and defending.

Literacy

We will be writing extended stories about a journey to the moon and the first flight of a young owl. We use our knowledge of word building to help us to spell unfamiliar words. We will be using exciting words and a variety of punctuation. We will also research and create an information sheet about an owl of our choice.

Science

We will be learning that animals including humans have young, their basic needs for survival (water, food and air) and the importance of exercise, healthy eating and hygiene. We will follow the progress of the Osprey eggs on the RSPB Loch Garten website and the eggs we will have in school.

PSHE

We will be learning to work together, to say sorry when we are in the wrong and to celebrate each other's achievements.

RE

We will be learning about Hinduism, the different Gods and some of the religious artefacts associated with the Hindu faith. We will also learn about Pentecost and what it means to Christians.

Topic

(art, DT, geography, history)

We will use paint, felt tip pens and chinks to create the night sky, the moon's surface and sunsets. We will design and create rockets using cylinders and cones. We will find out if the moon is made of cheese, taste different cheeses and make a cheese sandwich (optional). We will look at a map of the British Isles and find where different cheeses such as Cheddar and Wensleydale come from. We will find out about Neil Armstrong and the Apollo missions.

Music

We will sing songs/ play percussion instruments linked to our topic, working on rhythm, keeping time and memorizing lyrics. We will also listen to a variety of music including classical, indie rock, hymns and instrumentals.

ICT

We will use ICT across all areas of the curriculum, paying attention to E-Safety.
