

Maths

We will be looking at Number and Place Value. We will find 1 more, 1 less, 10 more and 10 less than any 2-digit number. We will look at place value of 2-digit numbers and identify 10s and 1s. We will use our number bonds to 10 to help us add three numbers and look at doubles to help us too. We will compare weights and capacities and measure them, recording our findings in tables and block graphs. We will be learning the names and values of our coins and notes and also learning about fractions; recognising halves and quarters of shapes.

English We will be reading the text *The Tiny Seed* by Eric Carle and following instructions to plant our own sunflower seeds. We will learn about writing instructions and how to use time connectives like first, after that and finally. We will also learn to use imperative or 'bossy verbs' when saying or writing instructions. We will also be reading the traditional tale *Jack and the Beanstalk*, thinking about the structure of a story and learning it by heart. We will be creating our own traditional tales based on Jack and the Beanstalk and publishing these into story books. We will also be learning some of the poem *Daffodils* by William Wordsworth and using this to write our own flower poems.

Music

We will be learning about pitch this term. We will identify changes in pitch and respond to them with movement. We will also relate pitch changes to graphic symbols and perform pitch changes both vocally and using tuned percussion. We will also listen to 'The Cuckoo' from 'The Carnival of the animals'.

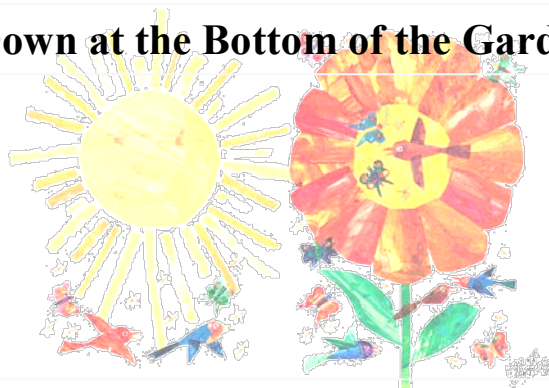
PE

We will be working on ball skills. We will learn how to throw and catch a ball with accuracy and how to kick and receive a ball.

Computing

We will be learning to use the internet safely with adult supervision. We will learn to explore a website by clicking on buttons, arrows, menus and hyperlinks. We will navigate 'back' by clicking on the 'back' button and complete a search under the supervision of adults. We will also learn to identify different devices that can go on the internet and those that can't.

Term 5

Science

This term we are looking at plants. We will identify and name common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees. We will identify and describe the basic structure of plants including roots, stem / trunk, leaves and flowers. Most importantly we will be growing plants!

Art

In Art this term, we are using the texts in our English lessons to inspire us. We will produce some art work in the style of Eric Carle and then make beanstalks using sculpture and modelling. We will use a range of materials to produce some daffodils towards the end of term.

RE

We will learn about the Jewish festival of Shabbat and how family is central to this celebration. We will learn that some symbols, like the Star of David, have special meaning. We will learn about Pentecost. We will think about what happened to the disciples and what has helped us when we have felt afraid.

PSHE

This term we are learning about relationships. We will discuss the people who are important to us and know how we care for each other. We will think about our feelings and understand how we make others feel.
