

### Literacy

The children will be creating fiction with an element of fantasy through our study of Michael Murpurgo's 'The Butterfly Lion'. They will then move on to creating some stories with an element of humour inspired by 'Billionaire Boy' and 'Mr Stink' by David Walliams, before finishing the year by creating some nonsense poetry, inspired by Lewis Carroll's 'Jabberwocky'.

Our SPaG lessons will focus upon recognising and applying adverbs and adverbial phrases in story telling, structuring poetry effectively using stanzas, and revisiting pronouns and determiners.

### Maths

In Maths this term we shall be revisiting fractions and decimals, before moving on to time and measurement. This will involve reading and using 12 and 24 hour clocks, reading and interpreting timetables and measuring using different units of measurement. This short block will be followed by a block on representing data to tie in with our work in Science and computing.

We will then be applying these skills to solve real world Maths problems, including the use of distributive law to multiply two digit numbers by one digit.

### Science

The children will investigate living things and their habitats this term. This will include identifying and classifying living things according to their features, making observational drawings, and presenting survey data using computer software.

### Topic

We will complete our work on the Romans this term by looking at Roman art and entertainment, including a glance at gladiator fights, chariot racing and mosaics. We will also look at Roman life, particularly focusing on home life and the Roman diet.

### Computing

The children will be learning to present data using logging software in conjunction with their learning in science. They will also be furthering their knowledge of word processing skills, and charting data using Microsoft Excel.

### PSHE

This term's theme in PSHE will be 'getting on and falling out'. This will involve the development of friendships and the resolution of disputes by listening to the opinions of others.

### R.E.

In R.E. this term, we shall be learning about the customs of Islam, including fundamental beliefs and marriage.
