The Big Fundraising Target

Last week we announced that we are going to set ourselves the incredible target of raising enough money this year to buy a class set of suitable laptops. The current laptops have served the school well for many years, but they're now becoming slow and outdated.

A new class set of laptops will make a huge difference across the school, giving every child more opportunities to develop their digital skills and take part in interactive learning. It means whole-class lessons can happen at the same time, teachers can plan more engaging activities, and children can build confidence using technology that supports modern learning. This investment will benefit every year group throughout the school.

Our aim is to put 75% of each fundraiser or event into "the laptop pot" and hopefully by the end of the academic year we will have reached our target.

From the events held so far this year (Quiz Night, Autumn Disco and Bonfire Bake Sale) we have added £1638.70 meaning already we have achieved an amazing 22%!




Last chance to buy tickets is Friday 5th December via the PTA events website. No cash tickets will be available for this event after this date.


