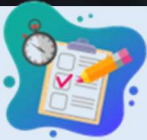
Brass Concert

Competition Time

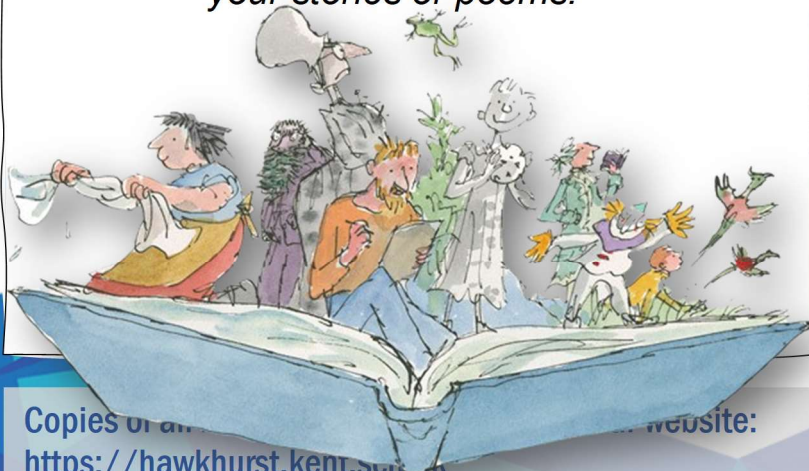
