It has been very busy in school with it being both Wellbeing and Football week. The children have enjoyed engaging in a variety of activities for both.




Staff and children are definitely ready for a week's holiday and we hope this will help break the chain of colds and coughs that have been circulating.

Week 3 The importance of Nurture for Wellbeing


In class the children were show the story; "Have you filled a bucket today?" by Carol McCloud.
