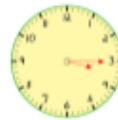
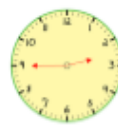
## Week beginning 29th April 2019

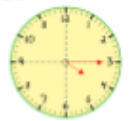
Match the clocks to the correct time..

Can you show the time on your clock?

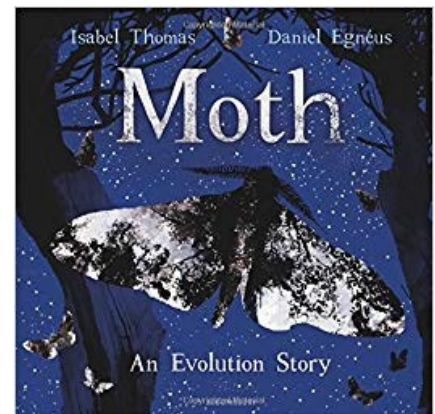
Half past 8	Lunchtime

Quarter past three

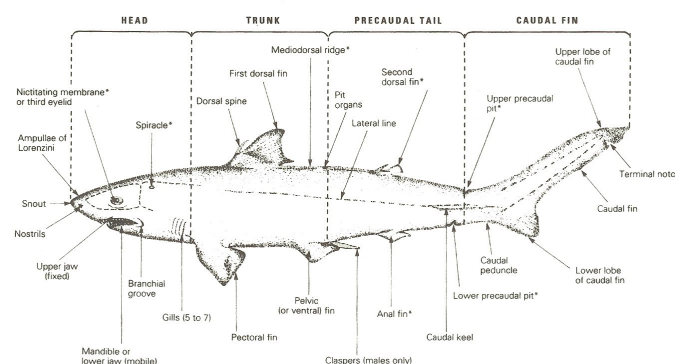
