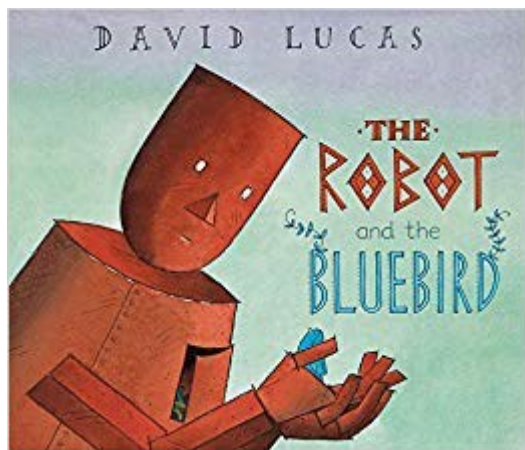
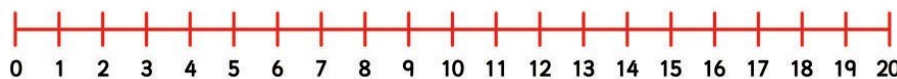
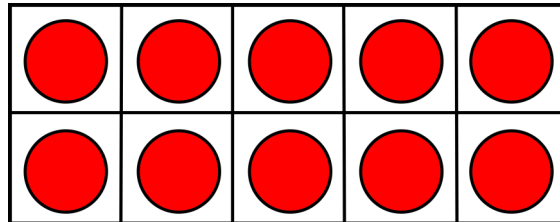


# Red Class

Week beginning: 13th January 2020

## Maths

This week we are focusing subtraction to 20. We will do this using beads, cubes, ten frames and number lines and using different techniques including first subtracting by counting back in ones and moving to subtracting the tens then the ones.



## English

We will be continuing with our core book, 'The Robot and the Bluebird'. So far the class have been predicting the story from the title and the pictures and exploring the movements of robots. This week we will be writing about how we think the main character feels and we will be continuing our work on using full stops and red words.

## Topic

This week in our topic of 'Toys! Old and New' we are going to be introducing the Victorian era and some of the toys that were present during that time. We will explore and investigate these toys and sort them into the categories of old and new.

## Science

Continuing our theme of 'Our Living Earth' the children will be carrying out a group presentation to the class. They will each be given an animal category (e.g. mammal, amphibian, reptile, etc) and find a fact using non-fiction books; they will read these to the class and will combine their ideas to make fact files.

## Home Learning

Your children could take a closer look at their toys at home, looking at what they are made of and how they work. This would help them when comparing modern day toys to toys of the past. They could also ask their grandparents and parents if they have any toys from their childhood to see how they have changed over time.
