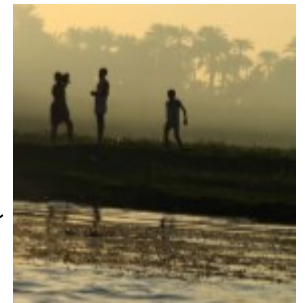
Week beginning 2nd March 2020

Maths

We are moving on from pictograms, tables and bar charts and now looking at length and perimeter. The children will be introduced to millimetres and will be practising measuring using rulers and meter stick and considering which would be the best to use.



History This week in our topic, Ancient Egyptians, we will be learning about the importance of the River Nile to the Egyptians. We will be learning about the various ways in which the river supported their daily lives and using atlases to locate where the Nile is. We will also be practicing using grid references.



English We are starting a new class book this week and will be exploring links to other books we have read and what we have liked or disliked about the book before we go on to write a diary entry from the main character's perspective.

Science We will be learning about substances that sometimes behave as a liquid and at other times behave like a solid, so are difficult to classify as a solid, liquid or gas.
